
Rich ended the meeting with an cute story about a husband's night out on the town. The meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.



WHAT'S IN A NAME, PART 2: When Renault debuted the Twingo in 1993 it was marketed as a "city car". Perhaps that was intended to discourage anyone from driving beyond the city limits in something so small. The design included what was called an "unconventional" front end layout resembling a smile. Was this deemed necessary in case anyone had buyer's remorse? It's hard to go to the garage and be upset with a car that's smiling at you. In 1994 a new model called the Twingo Easy came out featuring a semi automatic gearbox. From that one could infer that previous models should be called the Twingo Difficult. Launched as a 2 door 3 cylinder front engine car, by the third generation it had become a 4 door rear engine design. Finally a mid-engine concept model called the Twin'Run was made. Apparently the engine was so versatile it would fit almost anywhere, perhaps even on the kitchen table for rebuilding. Although conceived with centrallymounted instruments a popular option allowed the driver to use a smartphone as the instrument panel. Owners reported that a large piece of bubble gum (not included) worked well to keep the phone in place. Finally, when asked about the name, Renault reported that Twingo was a combination of "twist, swing, and tango". Even without a French accent it is unlikely Chubby Checker would figure that one out!


