#### BBB Website Year in Review - 2022

For those interested, during the calendar year 2022, the club's website saw an increase of traffic throughout the year. Key metrics from Squarespace, our web hosting service, are shared with all club members at this time. For January – December 2022:

- Total Visitors = 3,492 with a monthly average of 291 and those visitors viewed 6,852 different pages on our website
- Total traffic was up 15% from the previous year and page views were up 5%
- The busiest months were September, August, May, and June
- 54% of visitors came from searches on Google, Bing, or other web browser, 41% came direct, and 5% came from social media such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, and others
- Most frequent Google searches were 'British car shows', 'British boots and bonnets', 'car shows near me', 'Harper College car show', and 'British car clubs near me'
- Most viewed pages on our website and listed in rank order were our Events Calendar, Newsletters, Current Officers, Event Photos, and Contact Us web pages
- Not that it's a competition but Apple IOS beat Microsoft Windows, and Google Chrome beat Safari
- Desktop users beat out mobile users by a slim margin but the trend lines for mobile use are increasing and this may flip next year
- Website related expenses for 2022 did not increase.

I am looking forward to 2023 and using the website to continue helping support club members, officers, and guests with accurate and up-to-date information about as many club activities as possible.

#### DID - U - KNOW

#### by Facia Nearside

Anyone who has been around the European automotive scene for any length of time knows in the early part of the 20<sup>th</sup> century Brits considered three-wheel vehicles just as normal as four wheeled. Still, it is sometimes hard to believe just how far this concept extended.

By 1912 Napier & Son was a leading supplier of luxury cars in Great Britain, and were known for their innovative approach to engineering challenges. Because of this the London & North Eastern Railway approached Napier in 1930 looking for a replacement for their current form of motive power on local haulage, horses. The requirements dictated a tractor unit which could easily couple to existing horse trailers while retaining the maneuverability of a horse. Napier's solution, the Snub-nose Lorrie. Often dubbed the "Mechanical Horse" the tractor unit used a single front wheel which steered through 360 degrees. Built on a simple sturdy frame it had a square wooden cab and canvas doors. The Mechanical Horse came in two sizes capable of pulling either a 3-tonne or 6-tonne load. This agile vehicle had the ability to turn 360 degrees in under 20 feet with a 16-foot trailer attached.





Napier eventually sold the project to Scammell Lorries of Waterford who continued to refine and develop it, perfecting an automatic coupling and uncoupling mechanism. Known as the Scammell Mechanical Horse the tractor remained relatively unchanged until the late 1940s when a new Scammell 2090cc engine was introduced. The engine was mounted lower for greater stability and a rounded steel cab was designed giving it a "bug" like appearance. Known as the Scammell Scarab this unit remained popular with the railways as well as the post office and other users operating in crowded city environments.

Production of the Scarab continued until 1967 when it was replaced with one last updated version known as the Scammell Townsman. Despite the Townsman's many improvements, production was short-lived, ending in 1968 due to the mandating of new safety regulations and the formation of British Leyland. During the 34-year production run approximately 30,000 Mechanical Horses of all types were made. Today about 30 original Mechanical Horses, 60 Scarabs, and 30 Townsman are known to survive.
