





DID - U - KNOW by Facia Nearside

By 1945, following six long years of war, limey petrol heads were eager to get back into motorsport. Two very talented Royal Air Force pilots Rodney Clarke and Mike Oliver were among the most enthusiastic, and keen to develop a car of their own design. They named their company Connaught Engineering and their first successful road car was the L2. Connaught was a twist on the name of their shop "Continental Automobiles" in Send, Surry. L2 because their creation used the same engine as the Lea-Francis L-Type sports car, but they had reengineered it to provide greatly improved performance. The machine was then clothed in a slippery aluminium body which saved weight. Privateers immediately recognized the potential of L2 which led to success of the two seater at Prescott, Silverstone, Goodwood, and Blandford.


Encouraged by these results, Clarke and Oliver conceived of a bespoke race car. Fate smiled upon them when a 1954 rule change allowed Formula 2 cars to compete at the top level in Grand Prix racing. A car they called the B-Type was quickly produced and once again fate was on their side as organizers of the 1955 Syracuse Grand Prix offered £1000 to entice entrants.


The Connaught team found themselves facing a field of Maseratis and Ferraris, most with professional drivers, while they had chosen a relatively unknown 23 year old dental student, Tony Brooks, to drive their B-Type. Unfortunately the car arrived in Sicily late on the day before the race and Brooks had only enough time for a few practice laps.

Little attention was paid to the small British contingent, as the Italian teams were quite confident of victory before the hometown crowd. That all changed dramatically as the race got underway. Brooks in the Connaught easily worked his way to the front of the pack and by the time the chequered flag fell he was more than a mile ahead of the stunned Italians. So impressive was that victory the B-Type was renamed the Connaught Syracuse. And Tony Brooks, the first British driver in history to win a Grand Prix in a British built car? He quietly went back to being a dental student.
